**ANSWER:** As part of the design investigation for the Staten Island Ferry Fleet, NYCDOT is anticipating that the Consultant review all potential fleet make-up and vessel options. Included in this would be an investigation into the potential use of faster ferries with smaller passenger capacities. It is expected that the Consultant study all aspects and potential impacts of the use of such fast ferries, such as factors of speed, size, operating restrictions, etc.
